As the Planetarium Manager of the University of North Texas Sky Theater, Randall is responsible for the daily operations of the University's 100 seat planetarium which utilizes the Digistar 5 planetarium system in a 40 foot domed theater. The Sky Theater hosts 20,000 to 30,000 visitors each year. Randall has produced several of the planetarium's presentations which were customized to the Sky Theater's various audiences which include university students enrolled in our



astronomy program, public and private school children as well as the general public. Graduating from Texas Tech University, Randall spent 10 years at the Fort Worth Museum of Science and History before coming to UNT to assist in the opening of the Sky Theater. During that time he worked as a Planetarium Production Specialist and Manager at the Museum's Noble Planetarium as well as an Imax Projectionist at the Omni Theater. He has also worked with several national traveling exhibitions such as Soviet Space, The Treasures of Catherine the Great and The Dinosaurs of Jurassic Park.
